

**The Following Strategic Projects are available for investment**

**1- Chemicals, Petrochemicals, Fertilizers and Refinery sector:**

- A. Rehabilitation and development of phosphate plants in Qaim and the Ukashat mines (for local demand and export).
- B. Rehabilitation of existing fertilizer plant in Baiji and the implementation of new production lines (for export).
- C. Reconstruction and development of fertilizer plant in Abu Al Khaseeb (for export).
- D. New production lines for fertilizer plant in Khor Al Zubair (for export)
- E. Construction of acid and bases factories at the sites of Al-Furat General Company / Sadat Al-Hindiya, the Phosphate Company in Al-Qaim and the Paper Industries Company in Basra for local need (petroleum industries and electricity generating plants) and for export
- F. Construction of a new petrochemical plant (minimum 1.5 million tons of products) for export purposes, in addition to Al-Nibras project with Shell Co.
- G. Construction of five crude oil refineries in different refining capacities. The first is 300 thousand b/d in Al Faw port.

**2- Transportation Sector**

**A. Airports:**

- Rehabilitation and development of Mosul International Airport.
- Rehabilitation and development of Nasiriya International Airport, in addition to developing the Marshlands, and the Prophet Abraham Shrine.

### **B. Railways:**

- Rehabilitation and development of the existing Basra – Baghdad line
- Rehabilitation and development of the Baghdad- Mosul- Turkish border line
- Construction of a new line Baghdad –Umara- Basra
- Rehabilitation and development of Baghdad- Al Qaim line
- Construction of a Circular line Musaiib- Karbala- Najaf – Dewaniya
- Construction of Basra- Shalamcha line

### **C. Subway & Mono Rail Projects**

- Baghdad Subway
- Basra Subway
- Baghdad Mono Rail
- Karbala Mono Rail
- Karbala- Najaf Railway (if the circular line is not implemented)

### **D. Highways**

- Rehabilitation and development of the existing Baghdad – Basra highway
- Rehabilitation and development of the existing Baghdad- Mosul- Turkish border highway
- Rehabilitation and development of Baghdad- Baquba- Iranian border (Al Munthiriya) highway
- Construction of Baghdad- Kirkuk highway

### **E. Ports**

Grand Port of Al Faw including:

- Oil port
- Cargo port
- Special Economic Zone
- Transportation center, connecting the port with the existing highway (Basra- Baghdad)

### **F. Construction and Engineering Industries Sector**

- A. Rehabilitation and development of engineering plants in the Ministry of Industry and Minerals such as Al Nassir and Al Simood Co., Ibn Majid, The Heavy engineering equipment Co. (Ministry of Oil) and The Mechanical industries in Eskandariya.
- B. Rehabilitation and development of cement plants in Anbar (Kubaisa, Qaim, Falluja) and Nineveh (Badoosh, Sinjar, Hamam Al Alil)
- C. Rehabilitation and development of glass plants in Ramadi, in addition to building new plants for float glass in Anbar, Karbala and Muthana.
- D. Rehabilitation and development of thermo plants (special type of bricks for cement plants lining) in Anbar.

### **3. Housing Sector:**

- A. First phase/ building 25 thousand housing units in each province for low/ medium income people in addition to low cost housing for limited income people including the infrastructure (water, electricity, sewage, gas and telecommunication).
- B. Develop the previously known Al Rasheed Military camp into housing, commercial, recreational, sport and medical, facilities.
- C. Rehabilitation and development of the two touristic cities in Habaniya and Tharthar.

#### **4. Special Economic Zones:**

- A. Al Faw zone for chemical/ petrochemical industries and logistics.
- B. Huteen zone/ Babylon province for medium & heavy engineering manufacturing.
- C. Baghdad zone (near BIAP) for advance technologies (Smart city).
- D. Mid Euphrates zone for agricultural industries (agro-industry) in Dewaniya.
- E. Fine Engineering manufacturing zone in Nineveh (Al Kindi Co., site or Jabir Bin Hayan Co. site)
- F. Recreational zone in Diyala (the old camp near Al Khalis + Himreen and Udham lakes).

#### **5. Agricultural Sector:**

Investment Projects in agriculture in Nineveh, Muthana, Kut, Nasriya, Najaf, Anbar, Saladin provinces for strategic crops. Total area is around 1.5 million donum (1 donum = 2500 m<sup>2</sup>) for local need and the rest for export.
